## **Nora Angehrn will take time out after 4 years on the Ladies European Tour (LET)!**

*After two difficult seasons on the Ladies European Tour (LET) Nora has decided to take time out to recharge her batteries, and refocus on her goals.*

Nora Angehrn has decided to cut her losses from her average performance during the past two years on the Ladies European Tour and revisit the drawing board to come back better and stronger and someone to be reckoned with on the professional golfing circuit in the future.

After her successful 2006 season the targets were understandably high yet still realistic. However, Nora was unable to build on the past successes. The 2007 preseason training was marked by injuries which impacted her performance throughout the year never having the luxury of time to fully recover.

Despite all that, Nora showed an outstanding performance during Qualifying School 2007 where she regained full playing rights for the LET 2008. The subsequent training preparations proved satisfactory and top results seemed within reach. Contrary to expectations due to her revived motivation and preparation, Nora missed a few cuts at the beginning of her season, which impacted her confidence and increased the pressure for her to perform in the latter stages of the year. At the end, Nora survived only two cuts in 2008.

After assessing the last two years with her team, Nora has realised that getting back on track is going to take some time. As a result going back to Qualifying School in January 2009 is just too soon as she feels she is mentally and emotionally not ready to perform.

### **What's next? What are Nora Angehrn's plans?**

Nora Angehrn loves this sport, the competition and she knows what she wants – which is a place amongst the best European players. Based on her performance during the past four years Nora will be entitled to play some LET tournaments (Career Money List, category 12). In addition to her category status, her popularity and her good natured personality will also assist her in receiving some additional invitations to tour events in 2009 which means that she could play between 3 to 6 tournaments on the LET next year. Last but not least, Nora is hoping to receive an invitation to one of the biggest tournaments in European Ladies Golf and the closest to her heart– the *Deutsche Bank Ladies Swiss Open*.

Nora Angehrn is committed to using the time next year to working hard and advancing her game both mentally and physically. At the same time, she will begin the SwissPGA training as a teaching professional at Golf Club Breitenloo, who is very supportive of her participating in all tournaments that she is invited to. Nora Angehrn plans to return to the Ladies European Tour which together with the love of the game is one of the reasons why she is planning to play two tournaments on the Ladies African Tour in South Africa in March 2009.
